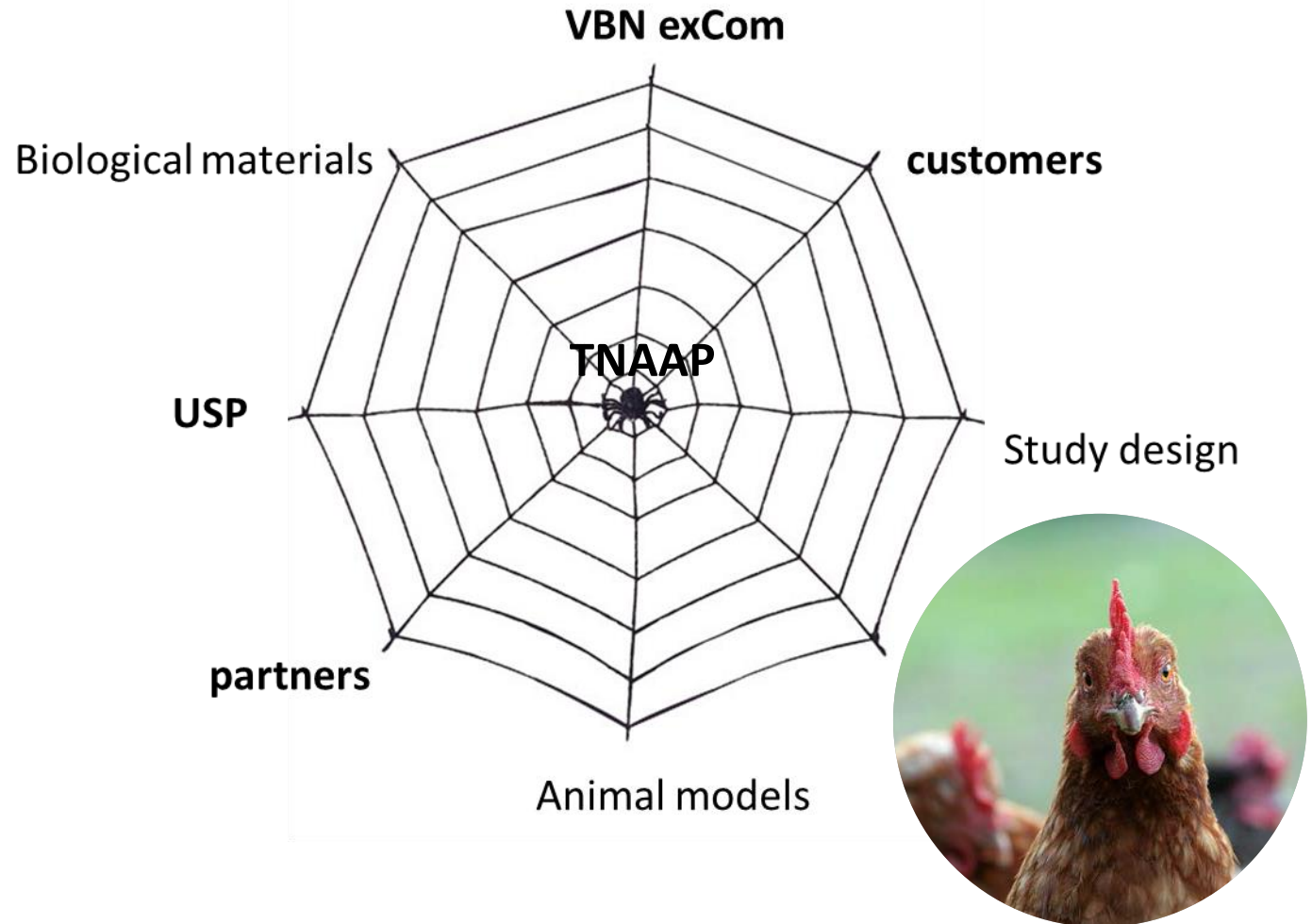

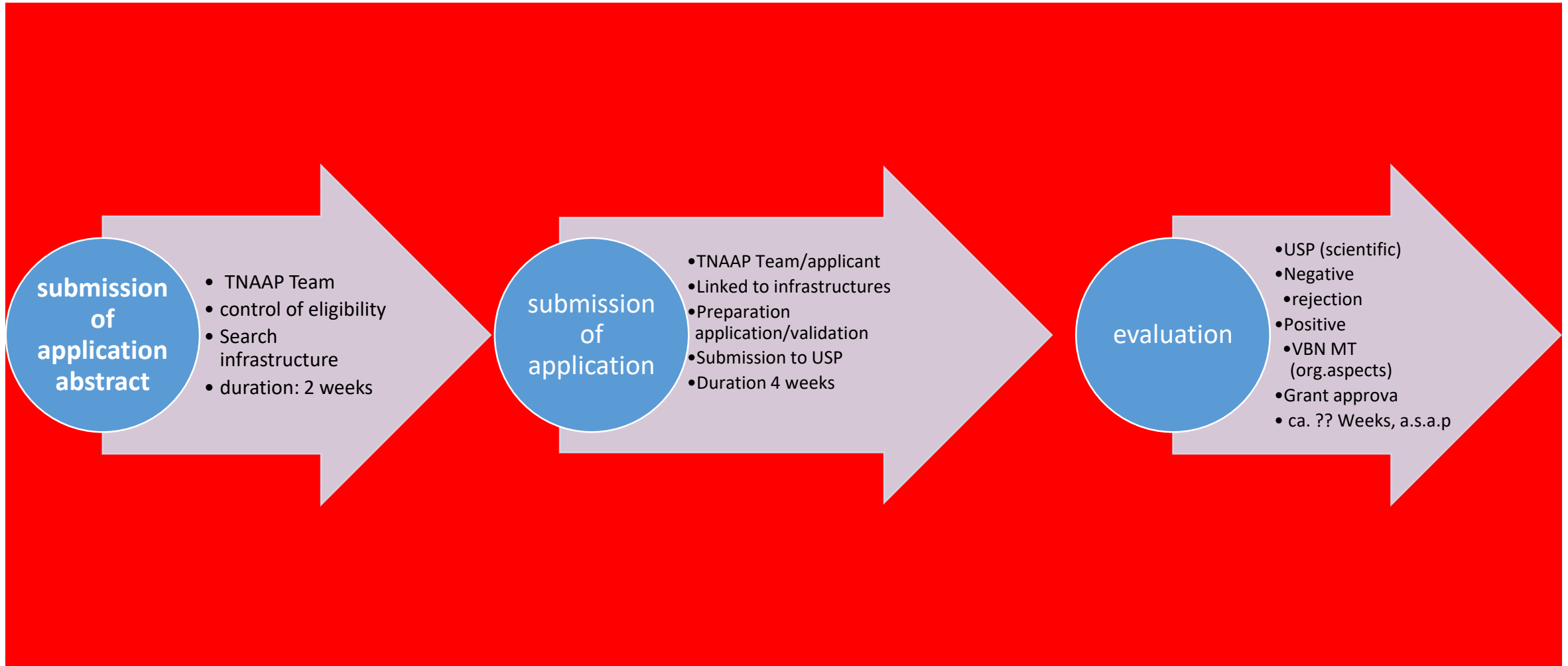

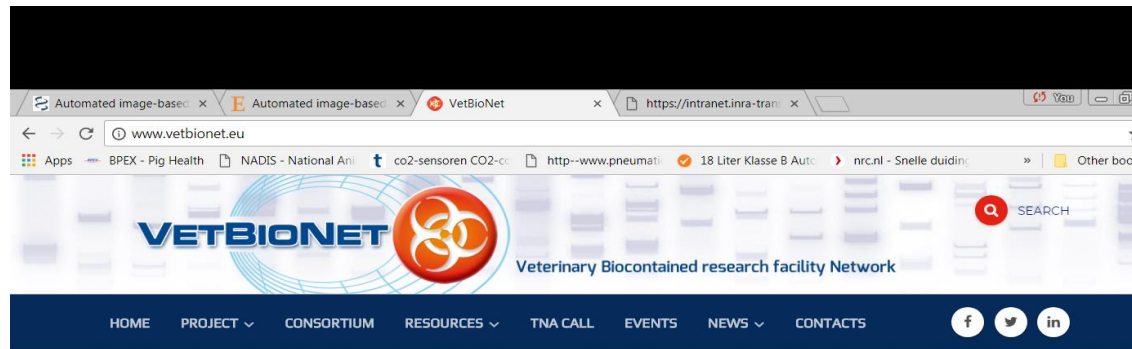

1. **Transnational Access Activities (TNA)**, consisting mainly in providing access to the BSL3 facilities and technical resources of the consortium. This **free-of-charge access** is provided to researchers or enterprises proposing a sound project related to epizootic and zoonotic diseases. As part of its Transnational Access Activities, VetBioNet also offers access to sample collections available at partner institutes and produces on-demand samples. The details of TNA activities appear in the "TNA Call" section of the website;

2. **Networking Activities (NA)** to foster the cooperation between project partners and to forge cooperative relationships with other European or international research initiatives, industrial stakeholders, international organisations and policy makers;



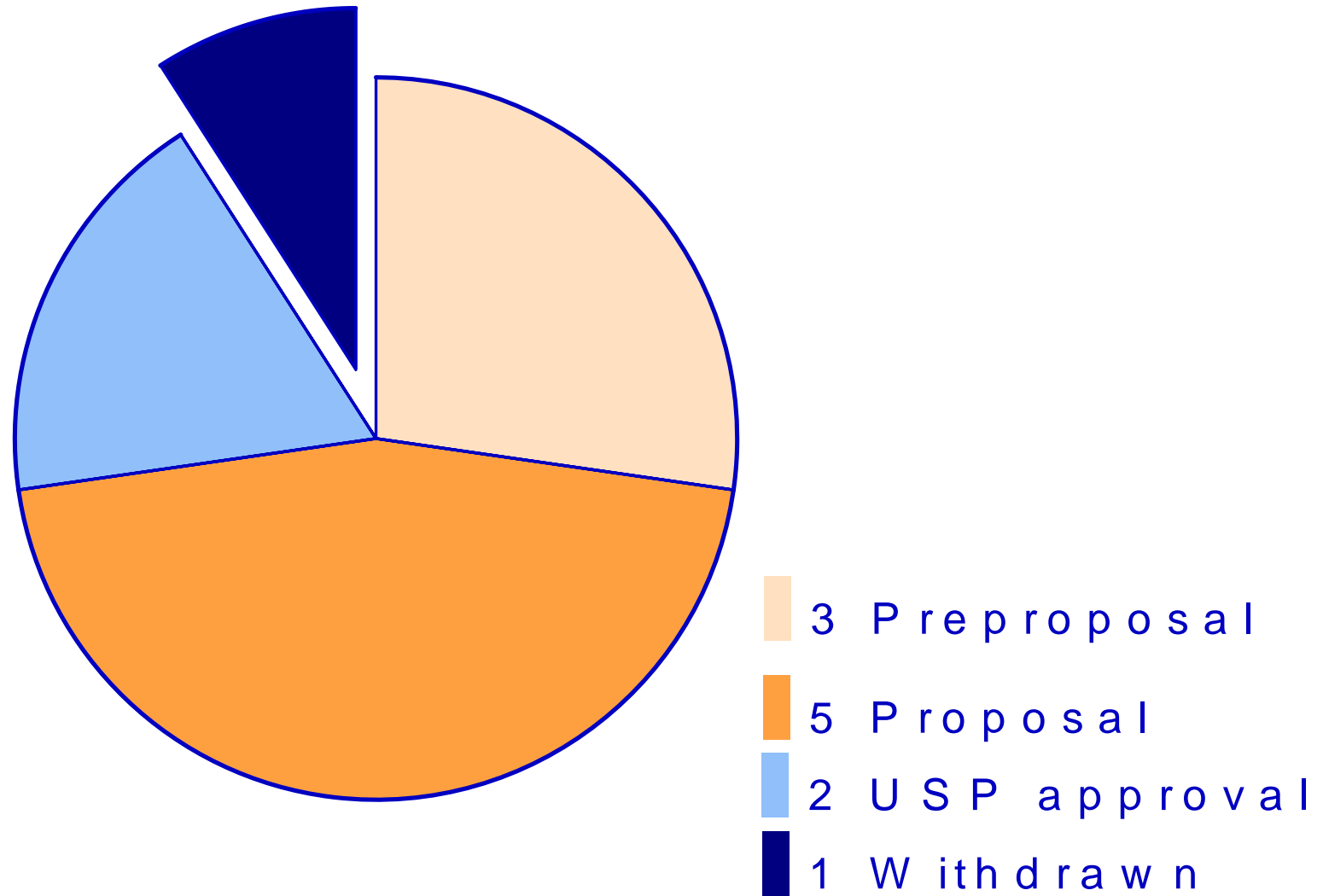
**VetBioNet Call for Samples Requests**
